As far as post-graduate level is concerned, 12 faculties were deputed. The report includes the assessment of performance of 12 nos of faculties.

12.Dr. D.S.Magarde:-



Year - 2016-17 REPORT ON FEEDBACK By STUDENTS

Level: Undergraduate

During the year 2016-17, 10 Faculties were allotted for the teaching purpose of BSW-I, II and IIIrd year. The report shows the opinion of studentws toward the performance styl of teaching, preparedness and echo friendly teaching-learning process. More over the report also shows individual evaluation of teachers performance. The evaluate over all performance certain components are determined and graded options were given. According to options, conclusions are drawn. Further dscrition shows faculty wise report.

- 1) Dr. V.M. Vitankar: Regarding the teaching of said faculty 85.33% students have agreed and highly satisfied about regularity of periods. Maximum (65%) students said that they easily understand. According to 80% she prepared well before classromm. She always promote students for interaction explain topic by giving appropriate examples. 64% students have revels that teacher attempt to resolve personal problems. The faculty always complete syllabus before university examination. She is taking usally koen interest about absentees and requied about reasons. Additional classes are being conducted usually (70%) which resulted useful for their improvement. Her teaching always gives inspiration for reading and study. From the opinion of 73.3% students, this is een that, faculty always motivated students to take part in other activites. She also look interesting and active in extention activities. She always use innovation and creativity in teaching, hence students fund highly satisfied about her perforamance, style, nature, conduct and friendly approach.
- 2) **Dr. M. N. Kubade**: There are total 24 students who submitted their opinions regarding the performance of faculty in teaching refring. This has been observed from the obtained data that 50% students are been highly satisfied, where as 45% are just satisfied and remaining 4% students are dissatisfied. Further this also came to know that 40% can easily understand teaching, 45% can just understand and Maximum (62%) says that she prepare better before classes. She always gives varieties of examples while teaching topics. She usually take part in sloving personal problems of students. According to almost (85%) students, the fuacity cover curriculum or syllabus. 92% student have agreed that, the

faculty conduct regular enquiry about students and seem helpful for slow learners. She conduct extra classes whenever necessary that gives motivation for study (95%). As far as participation of faculties in curriculum work is concerned, it is also good. About innovation and creativity she found attemptive. She provide additional knowledge and information and inspired students for classroom discussion. Her teaching style found good due to use of simple words.

- 3) Dr. Madhuri Zade: About the regularity of faculty in classes, 85% students found highly satisfied. 45% student have reported that they understand teaching verywell. However 10% students do not found agree. She keep social attitude and helthy nature hence her participation seem always infulencive in evary activities. According to 95% students she bring innovation and used creativity in teaching.
- 4) Dr. Sunita D. Bhoikar: About the regularity in classroom teaching 85% student found highly satisfied and students can easily understand teaching as the faculty use simple words and easiest way along with varieties of example and tools. In context of problem solving nature of faculty, it is reported that the teacher take adequate care of problematic students and giving them helping hand. The faculty also seen attemptive and careful about completition of syllabus. Moreover 82% students have been reported that faculty atted classes regularly, equiring about absent student and take adequate care of slow learner. She provided and guieded about study material and books. The total condut of faculty increases motivation level of students was the opinion of 94% stake holder student. The faculty also seen careful about participation of students in extra curriculr activities organized by the institute time to time was attend by (100%) students and to her inspiration, high level of satisfaction to and among them.

In addition to this the faculty always give more ideas, information and knowledge about surrounding areas other than part of syllabus. She promote opportunities for in house discussion, question answer session and interaction.

He is always an example of motivation. Always bring innovation in teaching (65.25%). We have obtain good comment of (64%) and 51.56%). He always provide additional information knowledge and share own experience. According to 54.00% and 62.50% opinion, he gives inspiration to student for participating in other activityes. He keep through knowledge of his assigned subject.
- 6) Mr. D. P. Hence there is greater need to bring improvement in teaching based performance.

About the over all performance this has been concluded that almost all students has shown positive view because they found fully satisfied (84%). Only 15% students has reported negative views.


SELF APPRAISAL RATING SCALE OF COLLEGE TEACHERS


YEAR 2016-17 STATASTICAL PIE GRAPH REPORT (%)



















FEEDBACK FROM STUDENT STATASTICAL PIE GRAPH REPORT (%) OF UNDER GRADUATE


